Gentlemen:

Morris R. Antweil hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising Lots 1, 2 and 3 of Section 2, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- Morris R. Antweil is owner and operator of a 113.2-acre oil and gas lease known as the L. W. White Lease, Lea County, New Mexico, as shown on the attached plat.
- Morris R. Antweil proposes that the above described acreage be established as a non-standard 113.2-acre gas proration unit in exception to Rule 5(a) of Order R-520.
- (3) The L. W. White Well No. 1, located 660 feet from the north and 660 feet from the east lines of Section 2, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed in the Eumont Gas Pool on December 24, 1955. The applicant proposes to use this well as the Unit well.

- (4) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
 - (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
 - (e) Morris R. Antweil is lessee and operator of the entire section of land as shown on the attached plat, and by copy of this letter of application, all operators within 1500 feet of the proposed unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of Morris R. Antweil to form the proposed non-standard gas proration unit. (See attached affidavit.)

In view of the existence of the facts herein stated and compliance with the provisions of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-520, Morris R. Antweil requests that the Secretary of the Commission approve the above described non-standard gas proration unit.



In accordance with our conversation, the L. W. White No. 1 Well is producing from perforations opposite the Yates Formation from 3528-3556 feet. Top of the Yates was encountered at 3174 (/ 398) and top of the Seven Rivers was encountered at 3652 feet (-80).

These correlations correspond with the Amerada-L W. White No. 1, located in the SE/4 SE/4 of Sec. 34, T-20S, R-36E, Lea County, N M.
