Reference is made to the following:

(a) your application (**administrative application reference No. pTGW09-19060415**) submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (the Division) in Santa Fe, New Mexico on July 9, 2009, and

(b) the Division's records pertinent to this request.

Williams Production Company, LLC [OGRID 120782] (Williams) has requested to drill the above-referenced well at an unorthodox well location, as described above in the caption of this letter. The W/2 of Section 36 will be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 320-acre spacing unit in the Basin Mancos Gas Pool (97232) and in the Basin Dakota Gas Pool (71599). Spacing in the Basin Mancos Gas Pool is governed by the Special Rules for the Basin-Mancos Gas Pool, as promulgated in Order R-12984, issued on September 3, 2008, which provide for 320-acre units, with wells located at least 660 feet from a unit outer boundary. Spacing in the Basin Dakota Gas Pool is governed by Rules II.A and II.C of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool, as most recently amended by Order No. R-10987-B(2), which also generally provide for 320-acre units, with wells located at least 660 feet from a unit outer boundary. This location is less than 660 feet from the southern and western unit boundaries.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 and 4.12.A(2).

It is our understanding that you are seeking this location for engineering reasons, in order to optimize drainage of these reservoirs.


It is also understood that notice of this application to offsetting operators or owners is unnecessary due to common ownership.
