Reference is made to your application for approval of a 150-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Bumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your State "TX" (Gas Unit) Well No. 2, located 1980 feet from the South and West lines and in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 6, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPL, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Bumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with Rule 8 of the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 150 acres after submission of the Commission affidavit of communitization to both the Hobbs and Santa Fe Offices.
