Gentlemen:

Texas Pacific Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under provisions of Rule 5(c) of Order No. 1670 for the formation of an 80 acre non-standard proration unit for its Sarkey, Well No. 2, a Blinbry gas well, located 660 feet FNL and 660 feet FWL of Section 25, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

In support of this request the following facts are presented:


1. The proposed non-standard unit consists of the W/2 of the NW/4 of Section 25, T-21-S, R-37-E and is comprised of two 40 acre units now authorized by NSP-644 for Sarkey, Well No. 1 and NSP-645 for Sarkey, Well No. 2. Texas Pacific proposes to abolish these two units in order to form a single 80 acre unit for Well No. 2 and disconnect Well No. 1.
2. The proposed unit can be operated more economically than two separate units due to the elimination of an extra meter run and the switching of two wells whereas Well No. 2 is capable of producing the allowable for an 80 acre unit.

3. The proposed unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lies wholly within a single governmental.
4. The length or width of the unit does not exceed 2640 feet.
5. Copies of this application have been sent to all operators as required under Rule 5(c).

In view of these facts, it is requested that the Commission enter an order approving an 80 acre non-standard proration unit for Texas Pacific Oil Company's S. J. Sarkey, Well No. 2 and abolishing units created by NSP-644 and NSP-645.
