Dear Mr. Smith:

Reference is made to your application on behalf of Weier Drilling Company for approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 28: SW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to Woolworth Well No. 3 located 990 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line and to Woolworth Well No. 4 located 1650 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of said Section 28.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, as amended, governing the Jalmat Gas Pool, Weier Drilling Company is hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 160 acres.
