The Atlantic Refining Company is the operator of the Walt Canyon Unit No. 2 Well, located in Section 4, T22S-R24E, on a tract of 691.84 acres. It is completed in the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian field pay. We respectfully request an administrative exception to the 640-acre proration unit requirement of Rule No. 2 of Order No. R-2440 and assignment of the entire 691.84 acres to our well for proration purposes.

It is our understanding that Rule No. 3 provides for administrative approval of non-standard proration units when such units are caused by location of wells at township boundaries.

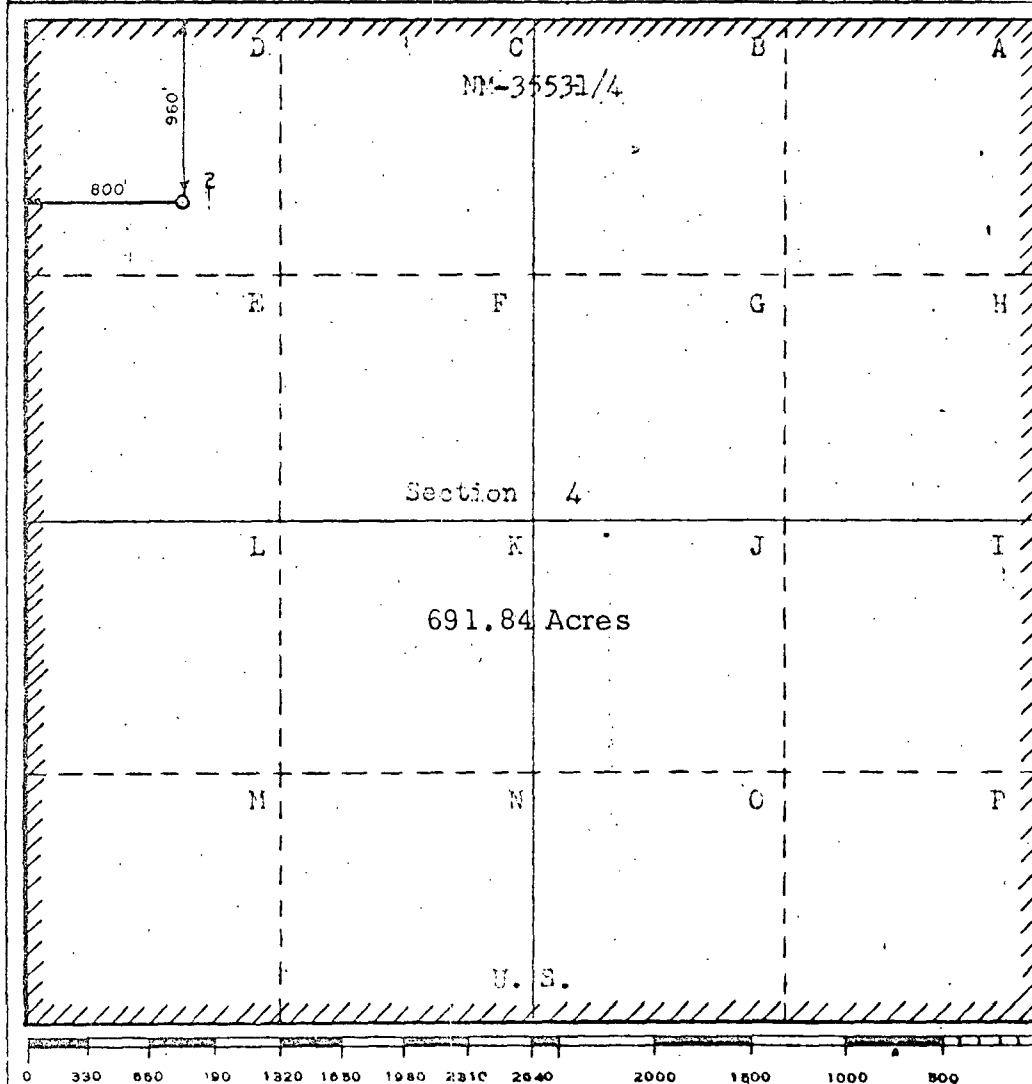
