Nika Energy Operating, LLC, on behalf of SG Interests I, Ltd (100 Waugh Dr, Suite 400, Houston, TX 77007) is requesting approval from the New Mexico Conservation Division for an exception location for the captioned well. NMOCD Rules state that if a well is located less than 660' from the lease line of the spacing unit, an approval for a non-standard location is required. The lease/spacing unit for the captioned well is the W/2 of Sec 25 (see Survey Plat attached).

The reason for our exception location request is topography. There is a lake/flood plain covering most of the NW/4 of Section 26; if the proposed wellsite were moved further west in order to qualify for a "standard location", the well would be within or too close to the flood plain (please see map attached).

As required by NMOCD, a certified letter has been sent to FIMO on behalf of the closest adjacent lease owner, Allotee 1700. A copy of the letter and proof of mailing is included with this application.





Nika Energy Operating, LLC (PO Box 2677, Durango, Colorado), on behalf of SG Interests I, Ltd (100 Waugh Drive, Suite 400, Houston, TX 77007), proposes to drill a Fruitland Coal Gas Well as captioned above. The dedicated spacing unit is the W/2 of Sec 25. A standard location requires the wellsite to be at least 660 feet from the outer boundary of the quarter section line; Our proposed wellsite location is only 317 feet from the N/S line of the section due to the close proximity of the Alamos Detention Dam (see attached map). If the wellsite is moved far enough west to comply with standard location regulations, the wellsite will be within the flood plane or inside the boundary of the dam itself.

In order to receive approval to drill on a non-standard wellsite, New Mexico Oil Conservation Division requires that all owners of the closest adjacent spacing unit be notified by Certified Mail. The owner has 20 days from the date of receipt of this letter to file an objection to our non-standard location with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division, 1220 So. St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, NM 87505. The director may grant an exception to the standard location requirements upon receipt of a waiver from the affected party or if no affected person has filed an objection within the 20-day period.


