Re: Application of Gulf Oil Corporation for
Approval of a Single 160 Acre Proration
Unit containing two gas wells producing
from the Blinbry Gas Pool, in Compliance
with Rule 29 (Order R-1670, amended by
Orders R-1670-A and R-3168) of Special
Rules and Regulations of Said Pool

Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for administrative approval of a single 160 acre proration unit in the Blinbry Gas Pool, covering the SE/4 of Section 34-21S-37E, to be dedicated simultaneously to two wells: Mark Owen No. 6 located in the SW/4 SE/4 Section 34 and Mark Owen No. 3 located in the NE/4 SE/4 of this Section 34, with a single unit allowable to be produced by the two wells in a proportion determined by the Operator.

In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

1. Applicant's Mark Owen Well No. 6 was completed in the Blinbry Gas Pool and assigned a 160 acre standard proration unit, consisting of the SE/4 of Section 34-21S-37E, on May 24, 1954.
2. Applicant's Mark Owen Well No. 3 was originally completed as an oil well in the Blinbry Oil Pool, but was reclassified as a gas well in the Blinbry Gas Pool effective July 1, 1965, and is now so classified. This caused the occurrence of two gas wells producing from the Blinbry Gas Pool within a single proration unit.
3. On May 8, 1965, two separate 80 acre non-standard proration units were assigned by Administrative Orders NSP-724 and NSP-725, consisting, respectively, of the S/2 SE/4 Section 34 dedicated to Applicant's Mark Owen Well No. 6, and the N/2 SE/4 Section 34 dedicated to Applicant's Mark Owen Well No. 3.
4. There are no wells producing in the Blinbry Oil Pool from the subject acreage.

5. It is proposed that, in compliance with Rule 29 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blinbry Gas Pool, the entire SE/4 of Section 34-21S-37E be re-established as a single 160 acre proration unit, dedicated simultaneously to Applicant's Mark Owen Well No. 6 and Well No. 3, with the Operator having the option to determine the proportion of the assigned allowable to be produced by each individual well.


