Gentlemen:

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission by letter dated August 13, 1973, rescinded DHC Order 33 and reclassified the Southland Royalty "A" Well No. 1 located in Unit G, Section 9, T-21-S, R-37-E, from a Blinebry Oil to a Blinebry Gas well. The well was shut - in and subsequent downhole work will be performed to isolate the Blinebry Zone.

As a result of the foregoing this application for an 80 acre, Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit is being submitted and is to be dedicated to our Southland Royalty "A" Well No. 6, located 1980' FNL x 660' FEL (Unit H) Section 9, -T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Acreage to be dedicated is the S/2 of the NE/4 of Section 9, T-21-S, R-37-E, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, Blinebry Gas Pool.
