

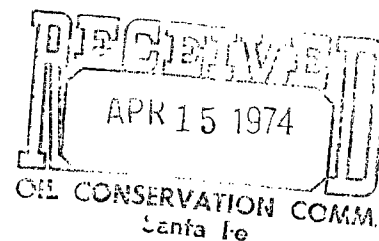

Gentlemen:

Atlantic Richfield Company respectfully requests administrative approval for a 160-acre non-standard Jalmat Gas proration unit comprising the NW/4 of Section 25, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico, to be dedicated to the proposed McDonald State WN No. 24, located 1780' FN and 660' FWL of said section.

At the present time, a 320-acre proration unit comprising the N/2 of Section 25 is assigned to the McDonald State WN No. 10, located 1650' FN and FWL of said section. Upon completion of the proposed McDonald State WN No. 24 in the Jalmat (Yates) Gas Pool, we request that the 160-acre non-standard proration unit be re-assigned to said well.
