Pursuant to Division Rule 104.F(2), Mewbourne Oil Company applies for administrative approval of an unorthodox oil well location for the following well:

<u>Well</u> :	SF "22" Fed. Com. Well No. 1 30-025-36347
Location:	660 feet FSL & 1090 feet FEL
Unit:	SE¼SE¼ of Section 22, Township 18 South, Range
	32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico

The well will be drilled to a depth sufficient to test the Morrow formation, and the location is orthodox in that zone (Undesignated North Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool). However, if the Wolfcamp and Strawn formations appear prospective, those zones may be tested. The well is in the Undesignated Young-Wolfcamp Pool and the Undesignated Querecho Plains-Strawn Pool. Both are oil pools developed on statewide 40 acre spacing. Attached as Exhibit A is the Form C-102 for the well.

The location is based on topographical and geologic reasons. The well's original location was 990 feet FEL, but it was moved west 90 feet to avoid pipelines, making the location unorthodox as to oil zones. <u>See</u> Exhibit B. In addition, there are several existing wells in the S½SE¼, which also restrict a well's location. <u>See</u> Exhibit C.

The primary zones of interest in the well are the Middle Morrow and Strawn formations. The proposed location allows both the Middle Morrow blue sand and Middle Morrow green sand to be tested. If the well is moved to the east, the Morrow sands thin and become nonprospective. If the well is moved to the west, it would be too near a fault. A location in the NW¼SE¼ would be prospective in the Morrow. However, a location in that quarter-quarter section moves the well out of the thickest part of the Strawn, and too near the Strawn well in the NE¼SW¼, which produced 546,000 BO. Thus, a location in the NW¼SE¼ may be depleted.


Working interest ownership in the E½ of Section 22 below the top of the Wolfcamp formation is governed by an operating agreement, and all working interest owners will share in production from the Wolfcamp and Strawn formations. In addition, the royalty interest in both the SW¼SE¼ and SE¼SE¼ of Section 22 is owned by the United States. Therefore, those parties have not been notified of this application.


There are overriding royalty owners in the SW%SE% of Section 22, and they have been notified of this application. See Exhibit D.


