Reference is made to your application for a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO  
TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM  
Section 22: E/2 E/2

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your SEMU Eumont Well No. 90, located 660 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of said Section 22.

A waiver of objection has been received from the offsetting operator and the waiting period may be dispensed with in this instance.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5(b) of Order No. R-1670, as amended, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit.
