Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for two non-standard proration units consisting of the following acreage in the Jalmat Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO  
TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM  
Section 30: NE/4

TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM  
Section 30: SE/4

It is understood that the first unit is to be dedicated to your Winningham Well No. 7, located 1922 feet from the North line and 488 feet from the East line and the second unit to be dedicated to your Winningham Well No. 3, located 1930 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the East line both in said Section 30.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104 D II, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as two non-standard proration units.
