This office is in receipt of your C-141 regarding the produced water release at this facility.

NMOCD Rule 19.15.29.11 states in part, "...The responsible person must complete **division approved corrective action** for releases which endanger public health or the environment. Releases will be addressed in accordance with a <u>remediation plan</u> submitted to and approved by the division or with an abatement plan submitted in accordance with Section 19 of 19.15.1 NMAC."

- Submit laboratory results of sampling as well as the proposed remediation with the plan.

Remediation requirements may be subject to other federal, state, and local laws or regulations.
