THIS MATTER having come before the Oil Conservation Commission on C&D Management Company d/b/a Freedom Ventures Company's Motion for Continuance, and, in the Alternative, for an Extension of Time Within Which to File Requested Finding of Fact and Conclusion of Law,

The Commission having reviewed the Motion, having heard oral argument on the Motion, and otherwise being fully informed of the circumstances, hereby finds that the portion of the Motion that requests a continuance is not well-taken, and finds that the portion of the Motion that requests a two-week extension of time to file requested findings of fact and conclusions of law is well-taken.

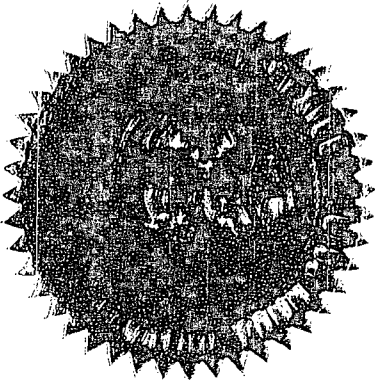
**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**
