In compliance with 19.15.15.13 NMAC, Hess Corporation (Hess) as operator of the proposed Mitchell 1830 181B requests administrative approval of our application for permit to drill the subject well to be located in the NW/4NE/4 of Section. 18, T18N, R30E. Hess cannot drill at a legal location in the SW/4NE/4 of Section 18 due to topographical considerations.

Enclosed is a plat showing the spacing unit, being all of section 18, T18N, R30E, the drill site located in the unorthodox location of the NW/4NE/4 of Sec. 18 and the adjoining affected units being all of Section 7, the SW/4 of Section 8 (subject to 160 acre spacing) and all of Section 17.

The affected parties are:

1. All of Section 7, the SW/4 of Section 8 and all of Section 17 excluding 1.01 acres in the southwest corner – **Hess Corporation** – 100%
2. 1.01 acres in the southwest corner of Section 17: **Hess Corporation** – 56.25%; **F&F Family Limited Partnership** – 18.75 % - unleased; heirs of **Charles and Emma Field** – 25% - unleased



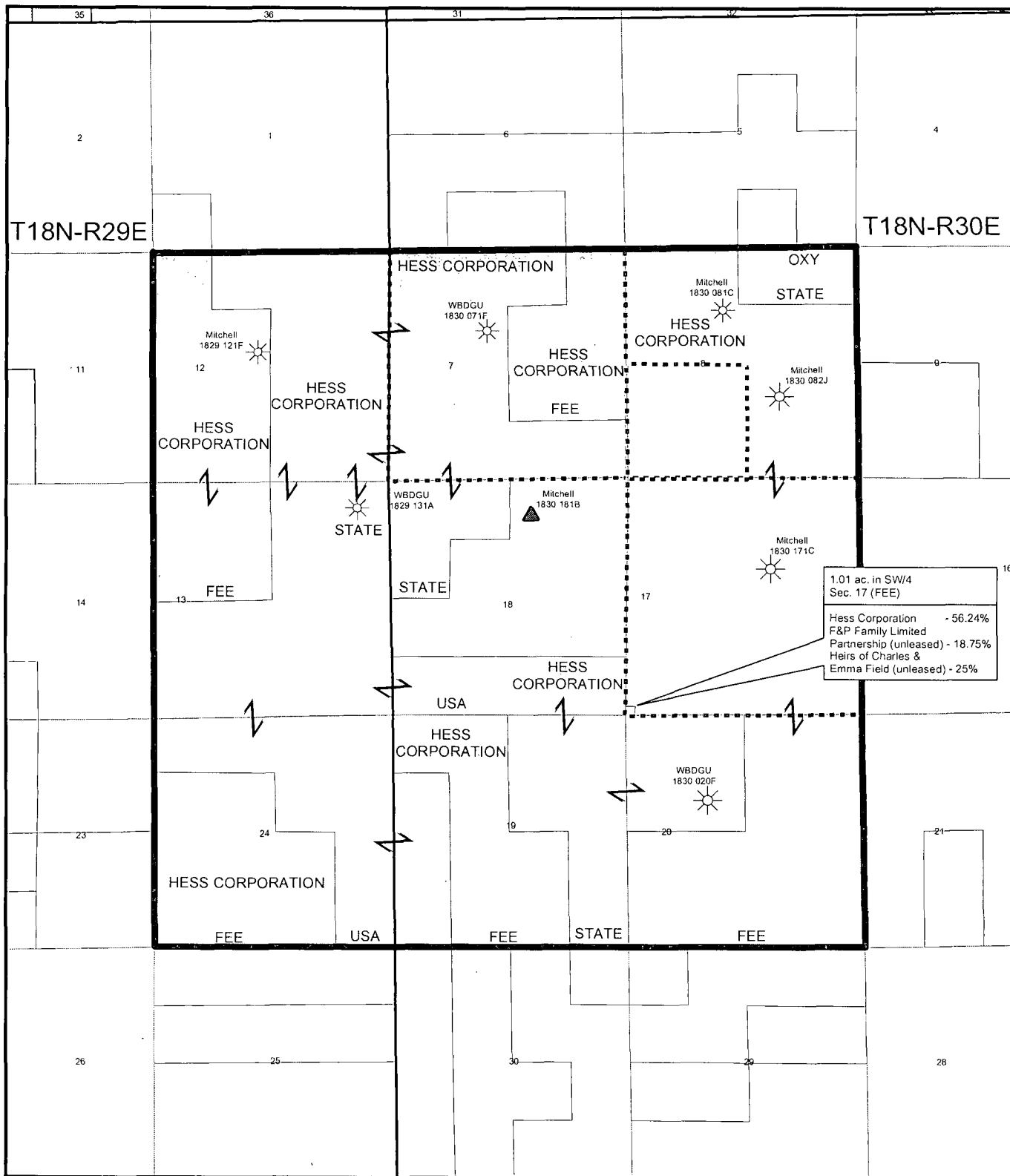

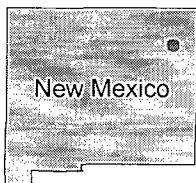

Dear Mr. Hughart

I have received your NSL application for the referenced well. However, much of the information I will need to process this application is apparently not included.

First and foremost, your letter does not state the proposed location, nor does it state the pool or formation in which the well will be completed, information that is necessary to ascertain what spacing rules apply. Also, I will need a copy of the Form C-102 filed with the APD, which depicts the proposed location and the unit that will be dedicated to the proposed well.

I am inclined to infer from the plat submitted that Hess is the operator of the adjoining units in Sections 7 and 18. However, there is no statement in your application concerning working interests in those tracts. Please state if Hess owns 100% of the working interest in the adjoining tracts in Sections 7 and 18, and, if not, whether working interest ownership for those tracts is identical to working interest ownership of the NE/4 of Section 18. We need this information in order to be sure that all required notices of this application have been provided.

In compliance with 19.15.15.13 NMAC, Hess Corporation (Hess) as operator of the proposed Mitchell 1830 181B requests administrative approval of our application for permit to drill the subject well to be located 1,200' FNL and 1,650' FEL (NW/4NE/4) of Section 18, T18N, R30E. Hess cannot drill at a legal location in the SW/4NE/4 of Section 18 due to topographical considerations.

A copy of the C-102 filed with the APD is enclosed. The well is to be drilled to a depth of 2,139' to test the Lower Tubb formation. Based on our records, Order # R-7737 covering the Tubb Formation in West Bravo Dome Field is in effect for Section 18 providing for 640 acre spacing. Hess has all of the mineral interest leased in this section and is the sole working interest owner of the leasehold. Upon the successful completion of the well as a producer of carbon dioxide gas, we will communitize Section 18 according to State Land Office regulations as we have previously done for other wells completed in the area.

Enclosed is a plat showing the spacing unit, being all of Section 18, T18N, R30E, the drill site located in the unorthodox location of the NW/4NE/4 of Sec. 18 and the adjoining affected units being all of Section 7 (subject to 640 acre spacing per R-7737), the SW/4 of Section 8 (subject to 160 acre spacing per R-7737) and all of Section 17 (subject to 640 acre spacing per R-7737).
