Oil and gas production from the wells shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated semi-annually. The commingled production from the wells is approved for off-lease measurement and sales.


NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules and Regulations. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.
