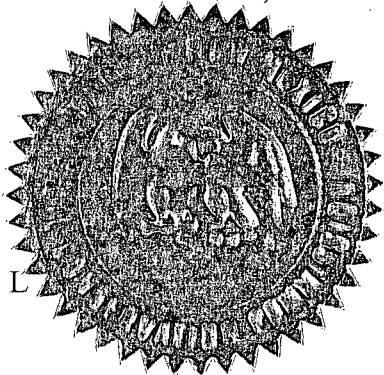
ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

- (1) On July 9 and August 20, 2009, this case was heard by examiners and Order No. R-13166 was entered on September 15, 2009 requiring Nacogdoches Oil & Gas, Inc. (NOG) to bring its wells in New Mexico into compliance with all Division rules by a date certain or be subject to certain actions by the Oil Conservation Division (OCD) for failure to comply.
- (2) On October 2, 2009, NOG, through its counsel, filed a timely application for de novo hearing. The de novo application was originally set for hearing before the Oil Conservation Commission on November 4, 2009. Having been continued a number of times, the matter is now scheduled to be heard by the Commission on April 8, 2010.
- (3) On March 26, 2010, NOG counsel requested that the de novo case be dismissed. Counsel for the OCD has agreed to this request.
- (4) De novo Case 14326 should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

De novo Case 14326 is hereby dismissed and Order No. R-13166 is hereby continued in full force and effect until further notice.
