

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Bleeder valve on circulating pump was left open after DXP replaced the pump on Friday. The fluid was released inside the containment walls. A vacuum truck was called out to recover the fluid inside the containment area.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

A local gang removed the contaminated soil from inside the unlined facility and disposed of at Sundance Services. The total depth of the excavation was 12" to 14". Due to not wanting to compromise the integrity of the vessels and other equipment, it was agree'd upon between NMOCD and Apache Corporation that when this facility is abandoned, Apache Corporation will at that time remediate this facility to the NMOCD Chloride Standard. The location was backfilled with caliche and chat.
