Barr Well Nos. 2 and 3 located at standard gas well locations in Units I and M, respectively, and to the proposed J.L. Barr Well No. 4 to be drilled at a standard gas well location 660 feet from the North and West lines (Unit D) of said Section 24.

Further you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject 160-acre unit from all three wells in any proportion.
