Dear Mr. Wright:

Reference is made to your application dated February 18, 1999 to simultaneously dedicate Tubb gas production within an existing standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit that comprises the NW/4 of Section 28, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Tubb Oil and Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. is hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Tubb gas production from both of the following described wells to this 160-acre unit:

- its existing Eunice King Well No. 18 (API No. 30-025-06855), located at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the North line and 980 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 28; and,

- its existing Eunice King Well No. 25 (API No. 30-025-06865), located at a standard gas well location 990 feet from the North and West lines (Unit D) of Section 28.

Further, Chevron U.S.A. Inc. is hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned this standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit from both wells in any proportion.
