XTO Energy, Inc. is hereby authorized to surface commingle gas production from the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool (71629) from the following leases and wells.

Lease: **Federal Lease No. NMSF-078872A**

Well: Bolack 4 Well No.1 (API No. 30-045-27729) Unit K of Sect. 4, T-27-N,  
R-11-W

Lease: **Federal Lease No. NMSF-078872A**

Well: Bolack 4 Well No. 2 (API No. 30-045-28771) Unit G of Sect. 4, T-27-N,  
R-11-W.

## **All in NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico**

Commingled gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured at the Bolack 4 Well No. 1 Central Tank battery (CTB), located in Unit K of Section 4, Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. **Oil production or any liquid production from the wells shall not be commingled.**

Gas production from the wells shall be measured continuously with calibrated allocation meters prior to commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated semi-annually.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules and Regulations.

The producer/operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.


**This approval is subject to like approval by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) before commencing the commingling operations.**



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FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Aztec District office of the Division prior to implementation of commingling operations.
