Comes now, Southern Union Gas Company (herein referred to as "Applicant"), a Delaware corporation with its principal place of business in the Burt Building, Dallas 1, Texas, and files this its application for an exception to Rule 1(a) of the special rules and regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool, promulgated by the Commission in its Order No. R-128-C, in establishment of the non-standard gas proration unit described hereinbelow, and in support thereof Applicant respectfully states and shows the following:

- (1) The non-standard gas proration unit for which approval is sought herein contains 335.75 contiguous surface acres substantially in the form of a rectangle and consists of all of partial Section 7, Township 32 North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.
- (2) Said proposed unit consists of contiguous quarterquarter sections and lots, and lies wholly within said Section 7.
- (3) In the opinion of Applicant, the entire non-standard gas proration unit proposed herein may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas from the Mesaverde Formation.
- (4) The well for which it is requested that the above-described acreage be the gas proration unit is the Southern Union-Page #2, which well is located in Lot 5 of the aforesaid Section 7.

- (5) In the opinion of Applicant it is not economically feasible to drill more than one well on the lands allocated to the proposed unit, and the well presently located thereon is capable of efficiently and economically draining the entire area of said unit.
- (6) So far as is known to Applicant, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, El Paso Natural Gas Company, Phillips Drilling Corporation and Pubco Development, Inc., constitute all the operators other than Applicant owning an interest in any of the acreage offsetting the proposed unit. Attached hereto are true and complete copies of letters mailed today under registered cover to each of said other operators.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, Applicant prays that the Commission issue an order to Applicant granting approval of the non-standard gas proration unit herein proposed.
