Application for Exception to Rule 6(a) of Order No. R-565 for Non-Standard Proration Unit, Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit comprising the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) (or Lots 3, 4, NE/4 SW/4, SE/4 SW/4) of Section 30, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

Re:

- 1. The Hancock #1 Well, located 1650 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 30.

 Township 28 North, Range 9 West, was completed as a gas well on March 19, 1952, and connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company's gathering system on April 30, 1954.
- 2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 142.74 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
- 3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- 4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
- 5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard gas proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.

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Therefore, El Paso Natural Gas Company requests that under the provision of Rule 6 (b) Revised of Order No. R-565, the Secretary of the Commission grant exception to Rule 6 (a) without Notice and Hearing, and approve the subject non-standard gas proration unit.
