of Order No, R-565 for Non-Standard
Proration Unit, Aztec Pictured Cliffs
Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit comprising the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) (or Lots 3, 4, SW/4 NW/4, SE/4 NW/4) of Section 5, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. The Duff #1 Well, located 1450 feet from the North line and 890 feet from the West line of Section 5, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, was completed as a gas well on March 18, 1953, and connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company's gathering system on June 9, 1953.
 2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 147.76 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
 3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
 5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard gas proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard proration unit.
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Therefore, El Paso Natural Gas Company requests that under the provision of Rule 6 (b) Revised of Order No. R-565, the Secretary of the Commission grant exception to Rule 6 (a) without Notice and Hearing, and approve the subject non-standard gas production unit.

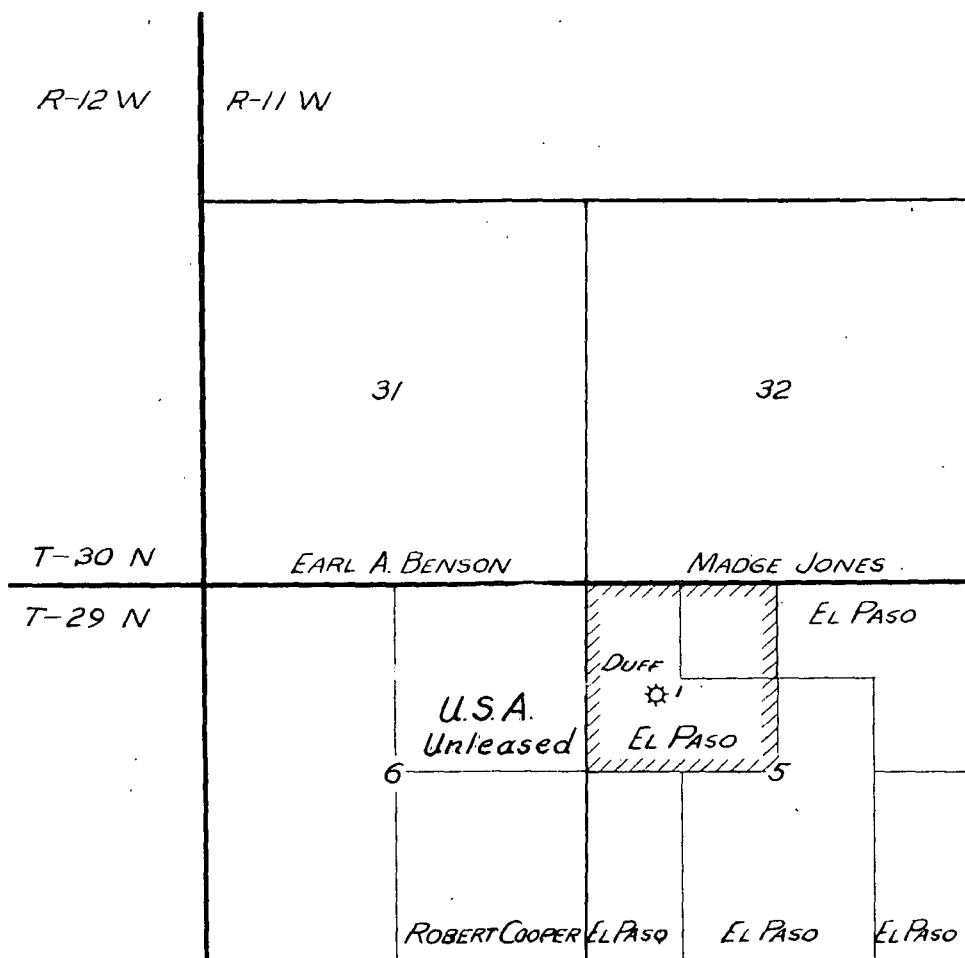
