The impacted area is located approximately 200 feet east of well in pasture Soil from the pooling areas was excavated and disposed of at an NMOCD approved facility Crew excavated contaminated soils; soils were placed directly into waiting trucks Vertical and horizontal delineation samples will taken and analysis ran for TPH, BTEX and Chlorides once all contaminated material has been removed
Depth to Ground Water: <100' (approx. 297', per New Mexico Office of the State Engineer); Wellhead Protection Area: No; Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000'; SITE RANKING IS 0. Based on site ground water quality and enclosed analytical results.

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division District 2 Office (OCD) is in receipt of an initial report Form C-141 reporting a release of produced fluids at or near the above referenced well site. The release reportedly was discovered on **April 26, 2010**. Please submit a corrective action work plan proposal (plan) for remediation, removal and/or clean up of contaminants that may be present at this site. The plan is to be formulated based on vertical and horizontal delineation of contamination, site ranking, and OCD rules, regulations and guidelines. The plan must contain analytical data from the delineation and a detailed site diagram identifying where and at what depth samples were obtained. OCD is to be notified 48 hours prior to obtaining samples where analyses of samples obtained are to be submitted to OCD.
