Gentlemen:

In compliance with your letter dated March 30, 1955, and Memorandum and Order #R-565 relative to filing applications for approval of non-standard gas proration units in the Northwestern Gas Pools, the following information is submitted:

San Juan Co, N.M.

1. The Smith #1 Well of the Locke-Taylor Drilling Company is located 2300 feet from the South line and 720 feet from the West line of Section 27, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, N.M.P.M., in the Fulcher-Kutz Pictured Cliffs Pool, Unit "L". OK

2. The non-standard unit comprises 109.0 acres lying wholly within a single governmental section. This well was completed on June 24, 1947, and connected to the Southern Union Gas Company line in January, 1948. The present-day spacing regulations were not in effect at that time. The unit comprised the Lawrence C. Smith ranch or farm.

3. The entire unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.

4. A copy of this letter, advising of the intent to form this non-standard unit, is being sent to all offset operators by registered mail.

5. Plats showing location of the well and offset operators are attached.
