Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits this application for itself and on behalf of El Paso Natural Gas Company for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the West Half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 19, Township 32 North, Range 11 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof respectfully states and shows the following:

1. That the Aztec Johns No. 1 Well, located 990 feet from the south line and 1650 feet from the west line of Section 19, Township 32 North, Range 11 West, was completed July 22, 1955 as a gas well and connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company's pipeline on September 30, 1955.

OK → 2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 311.4 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.

3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.

4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

5. That under date of June 1, 1955 Applicant and El Paso Natural Gas Company entered into a communitization agreement, approved by the Department of the Interior August 12, 1955, forming the unit proposed by this application.

6. So far as is known to Applicant, the following companies constitute the only operators other than Applicant owning an interest in any of the

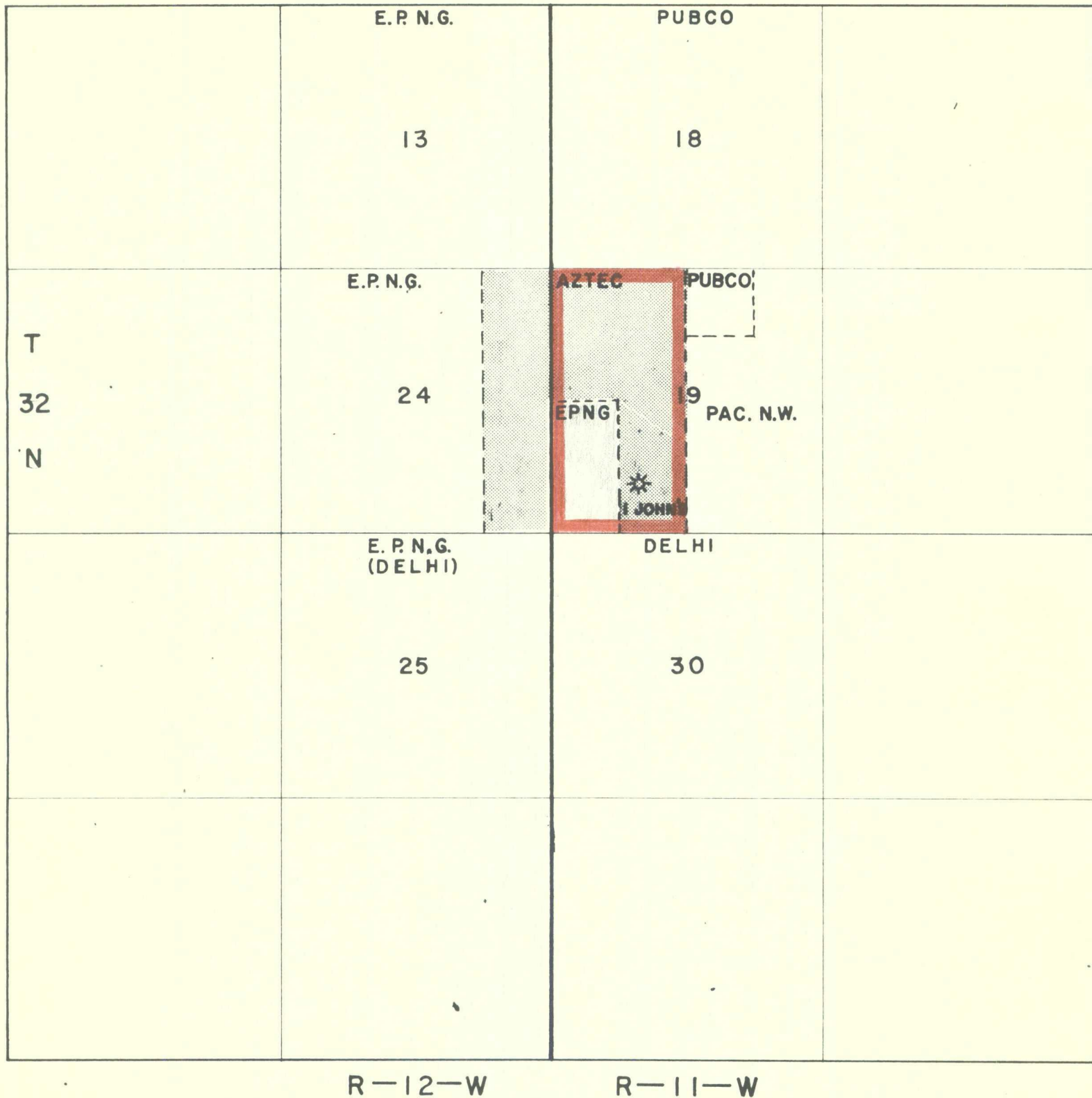
