Gentlemen:

Reference is hereby made to your letter of November 14, 1956 requesting permission of El Paso Natural Gas Company to the drilling of your San Juan 28-4 well #6-11 in Section 11, Township 28 North, Range 4 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. You advised us that the #6-11 well is proposed to be completed in both the Pictured Cliffs and the Mesaverde formation, and that you intend to dedicate all of Section 11 to the well as a non-standard gas proration unit.

Under the terms of the San Juan 28-4 Agreement, Section 11 is defined as the "drilling block" for any Pictured Cliffs or Mesaverde well drilled in Section 11. It has always been my position that when the Oil Conservation Commission approved the San Juan 28-4 Unit, they also approved all of Section 11 as a drilling tract for any Pictured Cliffs or Mesaverde well to be drilled therein, both insofar as well spacing is concerned, or a proration unit is concerned.

However, if our permission is required to obtain a nonstandard gas proration unit for your San Juan 28-4 #6-11 well, such permission is hereby granted.

Under the approved drilling program for the San Juan 28-4 Unit, Pacific Northwest was to drill a Pictured Cliffs well in Section 11, Township 28 North, Range 4 West. According to our information, this well was drilled to the Pictured Cliffs formation and temporarily abandoned. As a working interest owner in the San Juan 28-4 Unit, we have not been advised that you, as Unit Operator, propose to complete this well, and we would appreciate your advising us your intentions concerning this well.
