Gentlemen:

In accordance with Order No. R-128-C, Rule 1 (b), request is made for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit for Northwest Production Corporation "N" Well 10-7, which is located in the NW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 7, Township 26 North, Range 4 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The proposed non-standard unit for "N" 10-7 consists of the W/2 of said Section 7, including lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 contiguous to the W/2, a total of 329.12 acres. The unorthodox size of the proposed unit is caused by a variation in the legal subdivision of the United States Public Land Survey, and it lies within a single governmental section, all of which is subject to an oil and gas lease in favor of Northwest Production Corporation. It is reasonable to presume that all of the non-standard unit is productive of gas.

According to our records, and as indicated on the attached plat, Southern Union Gas Company, 1001 Burt Building, Dallas, Texas, owns the mineral rights in Section 12 and Atlantic Refining Company, Box 520, Casper, Wyoming, owns the mineral rights in Section 13, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, both of which offset our "N" Well 10-7. Copy of this request for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit is being given these operators by registered mail.

Gentlemen:

This is in reference to a request dated October 9, 1957 by Northwest Production Corporation for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit. This unit is designated as the "N" 10-7 consisting of the west half of Section 7, Township 26 North, Range 4 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The Atlantic Refining Company, as part owner of the mineral rights in Section 13, T-26-N, R-5-W, has no objections to the granting of such request and waives its right for a hearing before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission. It should be pointed out, however, that Delhi-Taylor Oil Corporation owns 50% of the mineral rights in Section 13 and that we are speaking only for Atlantic's interest.
