

Dear Sir:

With reference to letters dated November 5 and November 19, 1957, addressed to you from the Colorado Western Exploration, Inc., regarding their request for approval of a non-standard Mesaverde Unit in the Blanco Field, San Juan County, New Mexico, please be advised that The Ohio Oil Company has no objection to the proposed non-standard Unit. We would like to call to your attention, however, that previous regulations published by your office for the Blanco Field provide for an acreage tolerance of 8 acres, i.e., from 316 acres to 324 acres per Unit. In this connection, the Unit covering the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Section 7 covers 316.21 acres and for this reason would not be a non-standard Unit. However, as stated above, we have no objection to Colorado Western's request for approval.
