Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit consisting of the southwest quarter (SW/4) or (Lots 3,4, E/2 SW/4) of Section 30, Township 28 North, Range 8 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- 1. The Florance #6-C Well, located 1750' from the South line and 990' from the West line of Section 30, T-28-N, R-8-W, was completed as a gas well from the Pictured Cliffs Formation on September 18, 1957.
- 2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 153.23 acres, which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
- 3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single government section.
- That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
- That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard gas proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.

Therefore, El Paso Natural Gas Company requests that under the provision of

Rule 6(b) Revised of Order No. R-565-C, the Secretary of the Commission grant exception to Rule 6(a) without Notice and Hearing and approve the subject non-standard gas proration unit.


