Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit consisting of the southwest quarter (SW/4) or (E/2 SW/4, Lots 3, 4) of Section 7, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- 1. The Sunray #1-J Well, located 1090' from the South line and 990' from the West line of Section 7, T-30-N, R-10-W, was completed as a gas well from the Pictured Cliffs Formation on February 28, 1958.
 - That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 156.51 acres, which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
