Gentlemen:

In accordance with Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-565 Rule 6 (B), Application is hereby made for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit whereby 152.24 contiguous surface acres will be allocated to the Delhi-Taylor Florence #4-C well in M, Section 25, T 29 N, R 9 W, San Juan County, New Mexico. This acreage is substantially in the form of a rectangle and is a legal one-quarter section subdivision of the U.S. Public Land Survey. The proration unit for this well consists of the southwest quarter of the Section 25 referenced above.

This well is a dual completion with administrative approval having already been granted under Administrative Order DC-295. Administrative Order NWU-166 already granted authorizes us to operate the Mesaverde phase of this well on a non-standard proration unit.

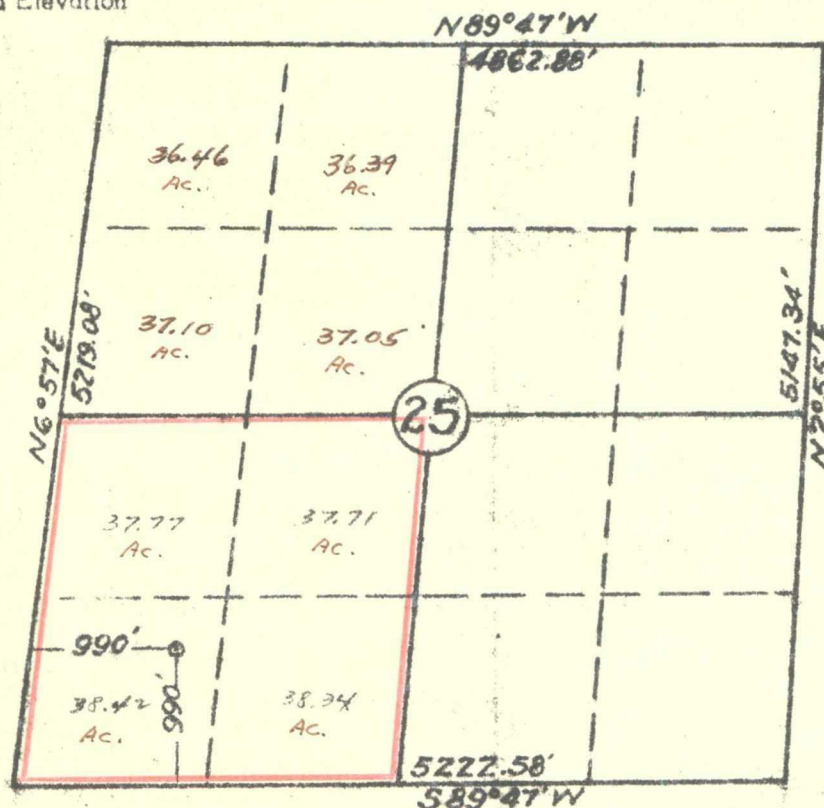

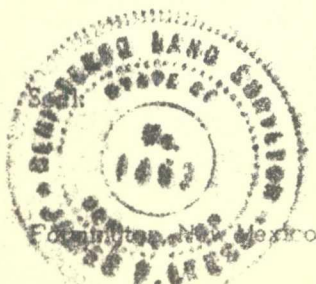
Ground Elevation
