Dear Mr. Porter:

Pursuant to Rule 6(B), of the special rules pertaining to the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, of Order No. R-565-C, Aztec Oil & Gas Company (hereinafter called "Applicant") hereby submits its application for an exception to Rule 6(A) of such rules of Order No. R-565-C, and it requests administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising all of Lots 13, 14, 19 & 20, or what may be known as the SE<sup> $\frac{1}{4}$ </sup>, Section 31, Township 29 North, Range 9 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico. It is further requested that pursuant to Rule 9 of said special rules of Order No. R-565-C, as amended by Rule 9 of Order No. R-967, and upon approval of such non-standard proration unit, Applicant be granted\_an\_allowable for such well in the ratio which the area of the non-standard proration unit bears to a proration unit of 160 acres; i.e. 152.8/160.

In support of this request for a non-standard proration unit, Applicant respectfully states and shows the following:

(1) The unorthodox size of the proration unit is due to a variation in legal subdivision of the United States Public Land Surveys.

(2) The proposed non-standard proration unit is substantially in the form of a square and consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections and/or lots.

(3) The non-standard gas proration unit lies Mr. A. L. Porter Page #2 April 23, 1959

wholly within a single governmental section.

(4) The entire non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

(5) Applicant owns all of the acreage within the section on which is located the proposed non-standard unit as is indicated on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.

(6) So far as is known to Applicant, Delhi-Taylor Oil Corporation is the only operator that owns acreage outside of the section in which the unit is located but which acreage is offsetting this non-standard unit, and such operator has been furnished a copy of this application with the request that it forward its approval of this non-standard gas proration unit directly to the Commission in order to expedite approval.

On April 1, 1959, Applicant furnished Form 9-331-A to the State of New Mexico, and it was erroneously stated in this Form that the drilling unit for the Cain No. 7 Well contained 160 acres. The United States Geological Survey, on April 3, 1959, was also incorrectly notified that the drilling unit contained 160 acres. By a copy of this application, Applicant is likewise notifying the United States Geological Survey of this error, and of its request for a non-standard proration unit for the Cain No. 7 Well.

WHEREFOR, Aztec Oil & Gas Company respectfully requests that the Secretary-Director of the Commission by administrative approval grant an exception to Rule 6(A) of the special rules for the Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool of Order No. R-565-C, without notice and hearing, approving the non-standard gas proration unit set forth above.


