> Re: Application of Aztec Oil & Gas Company for an Exception to Rule 6(A) of Order No. R-565-C for Administrative Approval of a Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit in the Aztec Pictured-Cliffs Gas Pool San Juan County, New Mexico

Dear Mr. Porter:

Pursuant to Rule 6(B) of the special rules pertaining to the Aztec Pictured-Cliffs Gas Pool of Order No. R-565-C, Aztec Oil & Gas Company (hereafter called "Applicant") hereby submits in triplicate its application for an exception to Rule 6(A) of such rules, and requests Administrative Approval of a Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit comprising all of Lots 1, 2, and  $E_2^1 N M_{\mu}^1$ , or what may be known as the  $N M_{\mu}^1$ , Section 18, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico. It further requests that prusuant to Rule 9 of said special rules of Order R-565-C, as amended by Rule 9 of Order No. R-967, and upon approval of such Non-Standard Proration Unit, Applicant be granted an allowable for such well in the ratio which the area of the Non-Standard Proportion Unit bears to a Proration Unit of 160 acreas; i.e. 140.99/160.

In support of this request for a Non-Standard Proration Unit, Applicant respectfully states and shows the following:

(1) The unorthodox size of the Proration Unit is due to a variation in legal subdivision of the United States Public Land Survey.

(2) The proposed Non-Standard Proration Unit is substantially in the form of a square and consists of contiguous quater-quater sections and/or lots.

(3) The Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.

(4) The entire Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

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(5) Applicant owns all of the acreage within the section on which is located the proposed Non-Standard Unit, as is indicated on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.

(6) Applicant is the only operator that owns acreage offsetting the Non-Standard Unit.

WHEREFOR, Aztec Oil & Gas Company respectfully requests that the Secretary-Director of the Commission, by Administrative Approval, grant an exception to Rule 6(A) of the Special Rules for the Aztec Pictured-Cliffs Gas Pool of Order No. R-565-C, as amended by Order No. R-967, without notice and hearing, approving the Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit set forth above.

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
