Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit adjacent to the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool consisting of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 13 WEST, NMPM
Section 18: W/2 SE/4 and SE/4 SE/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to a well located 740 feet from the South line and 760 feet from the East line of said Section 18.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 4, of the Special Rules and Regulations for the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, as set forth in Order R-566 (D), you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 120 acres.
