Dear Mr. Porter:

Pursuant to Rule 6(b) of Order R-565-C and to Rule 1(b) of Order R-1287, Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of non-standard gas units consisting of Lots 1 and 2 and $S_2^1NE_4^1$ of Section 5, T-27-N, R-9-W, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico with respect to production from the Pictured Cliffs formation and the E_2^1 of Section 5, T-27-N, R-9-W, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico with respect to production from the Dakota formation. Applicant further requests that an allowable be granted for production from the Pictured Cliffs formation in the ratio that the area of the non-standard proration unit bears to a proration unit of 160 acres; i.e. 149.07/160.

In support of this request for non-standard units, Applicant respectfully states and shows the following:

1. The unorthodox size of the non-standard units is due to a variation in the legal sub-divisions of the United States Public Land Survey.

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2. The proposed non-standard units consist of contiguous quarterquarter sections and/or lots and lie wholly within a single governmental section.

3. The entire non-standard units may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

4. The length or width of the non-standard units do not exceed five thousand two hundred and eighty feet (5280').

5. Applicant owns all of the acreage within the section on which the proposed non-standard units are located. El Paso Natural Gas Company is the only Operator of a lease offsetting such lands, as indicated on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, and has been furnished a copy of this application by certified mail, along with a request that it waive notice and hearing.

6. The location of the well to which the subject non-standard units will be dedicated and which has been designated the Hanks #18-D is eight hundred and ten feet (810') from the North line and one thousand eight hundred and forty feet (1840') from the East line of Section 5.

Applicant respectfully requests that the Secretary-Director of the Commission, by administrative approval, grant exception, as above provided, without notice and hearing, approving the non-standard units set forth above.
