

- 2. Applicant owns all the acreage within the non-standard unit. Operators owning offsetting acreage are Pubco Petroleum Corporation, and International Oil Corporation, and each has been furnished a copy of this Application with a request that their consent in the form of a waiver of notice and hearing be forwarded to the Commission.
- 3. The non-standard unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections or lots.
