Gentlemen:

In accordance with Rule 5(B) of Order R-1670-C, El Paso Natural Gas Company, as Operator, hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a Non-Standard Proration Unit in the Dakota Formation, comprising the E/2 (Lots 1,2,3,4, W/2 E/2) of Section 25, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, dedicated to the Frost #9 Well located thereon, and in support thereof states the following fact:

That the above proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of the number of acres shown and is an unorthodox size or shape due to a variation in the legal subdivision of the United States Public Land Survey. (Plat attached)

Therefore, El Paso Natural Gas Company requests that under the provisions of Rule 5(B) of Order R-1670-C, the Secretary of the Commission grant exception to Rule 5(A) without Notice and Hearing and approve the subject non-standard proration unit.

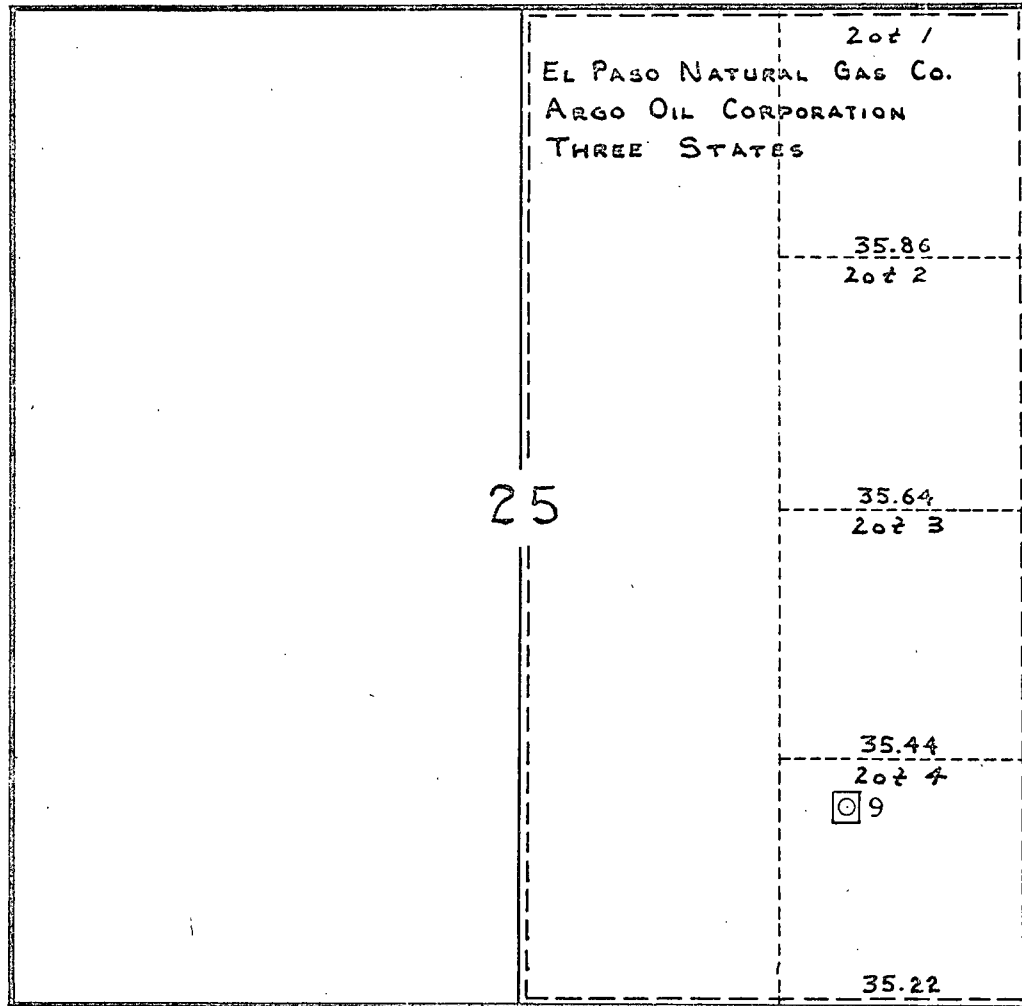
