Pursuant to Rule 1(b) of Order R-1287, Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its Application, in triplicate, for an exception to Rule 1(a) of such Order and Administrative Approval of a Non-Standard Unit consisting of Lots 1 and 2, E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , NE $\frac{1}{4}$  (N $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section 30, T-28-N, R-10-W, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.

In support of this Application, Applicant respectfully states and shows the following:

1. A location has been staked nine hundred and ten feet (910') from the north line and one thousand six hundred and fifty feet (1650') from the east line of Section 30 for the proposed well to be known as the Newman Gas Unit "C" #1-D.

2. Operators owning an interest in the Unit are Aztec Oil & Gas Company, Pan American Petroleum Corporation, Delhi-Taylor Oil Corporation, El Paso Natural Gas Company and Western Natural Gas Company. Operators owning offsetting acreage are Pan American Petroleum Corporation, El Paso Natural Gas Company, Delhi-Taylor Oil Corporation, Sunset International Petroleum Corporation and Angel's Peak Oil Company, and each has been furnished a copy of this Application with a request that their consent in the form of a waiver of notice and hearing be forwarded to the Commission.

3. The non-standard unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections or lots and comprises a total of 324.65 acres.

4. The non-standard unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.

5. The entire non-standard unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

6. The length or width of the non-standard unit does not exceed five thousand two hundred and eighty feet (5280').

Applicant respectfully requests that this Application be promptly considered and that approval be administratively granted pursuant to Rule 1(b) of Order R-1287 for the non-standard unit above described.

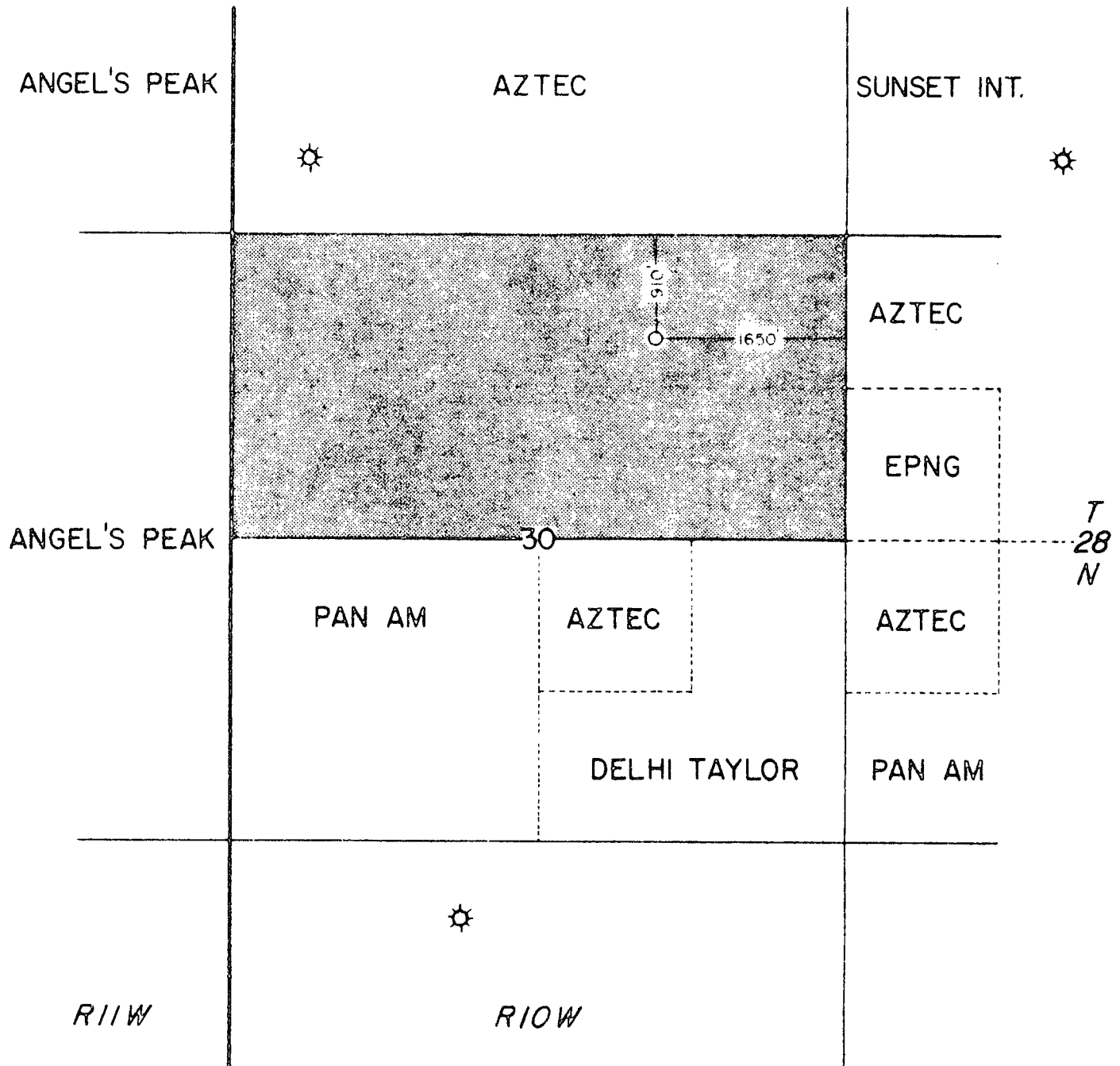
