Reference is made to your application for approval of a 301.02-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 12 WEST, NMPM
Section 15: W/2

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Richardson Well No. 9-D, located 790 feet from the North line and 1500 feet from the West line of said Section 15.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670-C, as amended, governing the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 301.02 acres.
