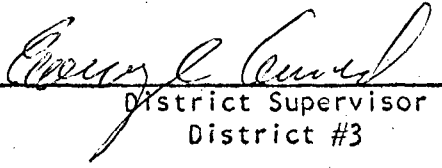

Pan American Petroleum Corporation respectfully requests Administrative Approval of a 324.75-acre non-standard Basin Dakota gas proration unit, consisting of the S/2 of Section 30, T-28-N, R-10-W, San Juan County, New Mexico. In accordance with provisions of Rule 5 (B) of Item A, Well Location and Acreage Requirements, under Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin Dakota Gas Pool of NMOC Order R-1670-C, the requested non-standard proration unit is unorthodox in size due to a variation in a legal subdivision of a United States Public Lands Survey. The following provisions are complied with:

1. The non-standard unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections or lots (see attached Form G-128).
2. The non-standard unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
3. The entire non-standard unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

The requested 324.75-acre non-standard gas proration unit is necessitated by the presence of lots greater than 40 acres along the western edge of Section 30, T-28-N, R-10-W. The attached copy of NMOC Form G-128 (Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat) shows the proposed location 955 feet from the south line and 1045 feet from the west line of Section 30 and the proposed S/2 Section 30 Dakota gas unit. All operators owning acreage in the S/2 of Section 30 have agreed to join in the drilling of this well and communitization agreements are being prepared. A map showing the proposed location in relation to other Basin Dakota Pool wells and offset operators' acreage is attached.

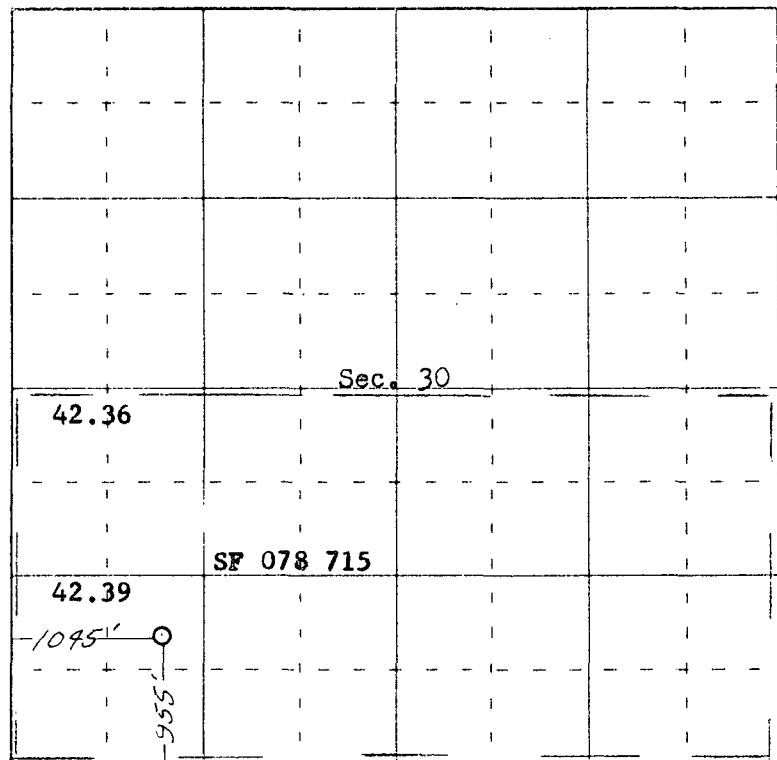

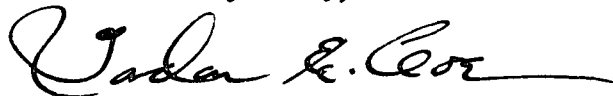

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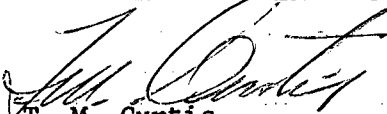
