

Tenneco Oil Company proposes to drill several Pictured Cliffs gas wells in the San Juan Basin. Most of these wells are located in T29N, R9W. This township has been resurveyed; and, as a result of that survey, many of the sections within the township are irregular. Consequently, many of the quarter sections are irregular, being more than or less than 160 acres. Tenneco Oil Company requests administrative approval for irregular proration units for a group of Pictured Cliffs gas wells located in this area.

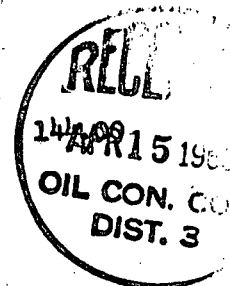
