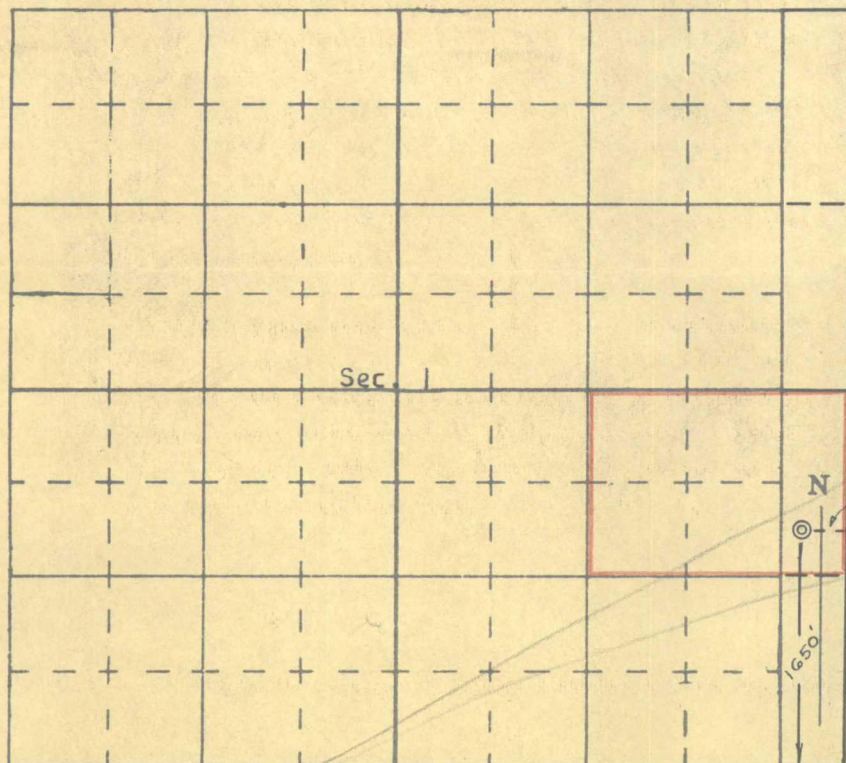


Dear Ewing:
