Reference is made to the following:

- (a) your application (administrative application reference No. pTGW10-24632371) submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (the Division) in Santa Fe, New Mexico on September 3, 2010, and
  - (b) the Division's records pertinent to this request.

Lime Rock Resources A, L.P. (Lime Rock) has requested to complete the above-referenced well as a directional well in the Yeso formation, at a location that will be unorthodox under Division Rule 16.14.B. The proposed bottom hole location will be 1644 feet from the South line and 2312 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 32, Township 17 South, Range 28 East, Eddy Count, New Mexico.

The NW/4 SE/4 of Section 32 will be dedicated to the proposed well to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit in the undesignated Artesia; Glorieta-Yeso Pool (96830). This pool is governed by statewide Rule 15.9, which provides for 40-acre units, with wells located at least 330 feet from a unit outer boundary. This location is unorthodox because the bottom hole location will be less than 330 feet from the southern and western unit boundaries.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 and 4.12.A(2).

Jurisdiction of this case is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
