The above named company is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and natural gas production from the following operated wells within the following pools and acreage all located in Section 4, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Paddock (Oil 49210) Pool

Texaco E.A. Sticher Well No. 1 (API: 30-025-10038), 40 acres, NE/4 SW/4

Southwest Eunice-San Andres (Oil 24180) Pool

Texaco E.A. Sticher Well No. 4 (API: 30-025-10041), 40 acres, NW/4 SW/4

Penrose Skelly-Grayburg (Oil 50350) Pool

Texaco E.A. Sticher Well No. 2 (API: 30-025-10039), 40 acres, NW/4 SW/4

Texaco E.A. Sticher Well No. 3 (API: 30-025-10040), 40 acres, NE/4 SW/4

Each grouping of wells with identical ownership shall be continuously metered prior to sales. Within each identically owned set of wells, allocation of production and sales shall be according to periodic well tests.

The measurement and sales point for commingled hydrocarbons may occur off lease. The producer is responsible for notifying the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Hobbs district office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling process.
