The remediation proposal for the Caddo Fed 6 release is approved with the following stipulations:

--The BLM will require confirmation sampling of the bottom of the excavation prior to closure.

In such an event that future issues with contaminants are encountered, the operator will be asked to address the situation until contaminant issues are fully addressed. In addition, BLM approval does not relieve the operator of responsibility for compliance with any other federal, state, or local laws/regulations.
