ConocoPhillips Company is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from Maljamar; Yeso, West Pool (**44500**) from the following leases and wells.

All in NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico

Commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in Unit O of Section 16, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Oil and gas production shall be measured continuously with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The oil and gas allocation meters shall be calibrated monthly.


