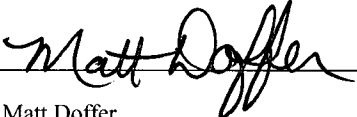

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

While flowing back water disposal well to 3 – 500bbl fiberglass tanks to reduce pressure on the well the haul off trucks were unable to keep up and the tank overflowed 30 bbls of produced water out the top hatch before it could be shut off. The overflow was contained inside the bermed area and 25 bbls was vacuumed up and hauled off to disposal.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

A remediation program for inside the diked area of the tanks is being prepared and will be submitted for approval.
